

Sponsored Participation through the IAEA Technical Cooperation Programme

The International Atomic Energy Agency will provide financial support for the **virtual participation** of candidates from [Member States involved in the IAEA Technical Cooperation Programme](#) to attend the **29th Women in Nuclear Global Annual Conference (WiN-2022)** which will take place as a hybrid event from 23 to 26 May 2022 in Japan.

Requirements and procedures to apply for the financial support:

- Candidates should prepare and submit an **e-Poster** according to the website instructions described in: [e-Poster | 2022 Women in Nuclear Global Annual Conference \[WiN-2022\] \(win-global2022.com\)](#), which does not require pre-registration. Once the selection process is completed WiN will confirm whether the selected candidates have submitted the e-Poster.

Please disregard the deadline indicated on the website as e-Posters from IAEA TC applicants are still considered by the Organizing Committee.

- Applications must be sent through the usual official channels (National Liaison Officer/ National Coordinator for Regional Agreements) by using the IAEA InTouch+ platform (<https://intouchplus.iaea.org/ITP/faces/main.jsf>). **The application will require a project and event code:**

The financial support will cover the registration fee. Kindly note that candidates should not register themselves on the conference website as this would require the immediate payment of the registration fees.
